

Dr. Jonathan Aleck, General Manager of the Legal Affairs, Regulatory Policy and International Strategy branch of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority



Dr. Aleck was Australia's representative on the Council of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) from 1998 to 2003. He chaired the ICAO Safety Information Protection Task Force and currently chairs the ICAO Safety Information Protection Implementation Group.

He is a Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society and the Australian Institute of Management, and recently concluded his second term as President of the Australian Institute of Administrative Law.

Dr Aleck earned his law degree at Loyola Marymount University. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology and a Master of Arts degree in political science from the University of Oregon, and a Doctorate of Philosophy in law from the Australian National University.
