

## Jon Beatty, President and CEO, Flight Safety Foundation



Jon Beatty became president and CEO of the Flight Safety Foundation in April, 2014. In this position, he oversees all operations of the Foundation, an international non-profit founded in 1947 in order to advance aviation safety.

Prior to joining the Foundation, Jon was President and CEO International Aero Engines (IAE) a division of United Technologies Corporation (UTX) from 2007 – 2009 and again from 2012 – 2013. IAE powers over 200 customers operating in 95 countries. Jon was also an IAE Executive Board Member.

Jon was the Pratt & Whitney Senior Vice President, Airline Customers from 2010 to 2012. In this role, he was responsible for global sales marketing and customer support and building and sustaining relationships.

He was also Pratt & Whitney Vice President for Operational Commercial Engine Programs from 2002 until 2006, where he carried responsibility for all in-service commercial engine programs with over 14,000 engines operating worldwide. During this time, he was a member of the Pratt & Whitney Safety Board.

Before joining Pratt & Whitney, Jon was Vice President, Programs & Marketing at BF Goodrich, responsible for Commercial and Military Programs. Earlier he worked at Allied Signal as General Manager with responsibility for OEM production and multiple overhaul and repair facilities. He started his career at Sikorsky Aircraft as a Quality Engineer.
