Ken Quinn is a partner and head of Pillsbury's top-ranked aviation, aerospace, and transportation practice and its Unmanned Aircraft Systems focus team. He has served on the Governing Committee and as General Counsel and Secretary of the Flight Safety Foundation since 2004. He was Chief Counsel of the Federal Aviation Administration from 1991-93 and served as counselor to the Secretary of Transportation from 1989-91. He served as President of the International Aviation Club of Washington, DC in 2015 and has served on its board since 2008. In February 2015, he served as a delegate to the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) High Level Safety Conference, after serving on

ICAO's Task Force on Regional Conflict Zones in the wake of MH17.

In 2014, he was appointed as an Arbitrator to the Experts Committee of the Shanghai International Aviation Arbitration Court. He also served as the Facilitator for the first-ever ICAO Council Retreat. He has served on the Governing Committee of the ABA Forum on Air and Space Law since 1994, including as Chair in 1996-98, and as Editor-in-Chief of its legal journal, *The Air & Space Lawyer*, from 1997-2010. He was named a Fellow of the Royal Aeronautical Society in 2006, and has served as counsel on the Board of its Washington, DC Chapter since 2008.
