

**Captain Scott Schwartz PhD, Dangerous Goods Program Director, Air Line Pilots Association International.**



Scott Schwartz serves as Chairman of the International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Associations (IFALPA) Dangerous Goods Committee and is a member of the ICAO Dangerous Goods Panel. He has represented both the North American and worldwide pilot communities at various regulatory and industry venues.

Since completing a second term as an elected representative on the FedEx ALPA governing board in 2009, Scott has worked on dangerous goods related issues for ALPA and IFALPA.

He is a full time MD-11 Captain and Line Check Airman flying and instructing worldwide with FedEx. Scott started flying as a general aviation pilot in 1977, and has flown for FedEx for 27 years after flying for two other airlines.

He earned a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1981 and Ph.D. in the same field at the University of Minnesota in 1986.
