Henry joined Aer Lingus in 1978 as a Cadet Pilot and has extensive experience on most Boeing and Airbus types as well as other regional type aircraft.

He was Fleet Manager and subsequently appointed Chief Pilot and Flight Operations Manager for Aer

Lingus. He completed his tenure in Aer Lingus as Safety Director and Crisis Director.
