These interactions fueled an interest in pilot wellbeing, and for the last two years Paul has led a research team consisting of psychologists from Trinity College Dublin and St. John of Gods Hospital, Dublin. This team have been examining the effects of working as a pilot on a pilot's wellbeing, and the subsequent impact on air safety.
