Claude was nominated by Canada, and appointed by the ICAO Council to the Air Navigation Commission (ANC), where he currently serves as the 1st Vice-President, while also being an Alternate Representative of Canada to ICAO. Claude is currently Chairing the ANC Group on Implementation and was previously Chair of the ANC Group on Safety Management Systems.

Claude's substantive position is as Associate Director, Operations, with Transport Canada, where he managed and led teams with responsibilities in aviation safety regulatory oversight. Prior to joining Transport Canada, Claude flew for many years, more recently as base manager, technical pilot, type rating examiner, and training pilot in different roles from air ambulance to helicopter offshore flying. Previously, he flew for the Canadian Forces in both tactical and SAR roles. He holds a B.Sc.(Applied) from the Royal Military College of Canada.
