The human role in aviation, while one of the most important components, might be the least easily understood. In a similar paradox, humans are deemed a necessary resource for both flexibility and resilience in aviation. With such a complex nature, it is not surprising that the topic of human factors has been widely studied to better comprehend how people behave and perform, and their ability to integrate with technology safely and efficiently. The pandemic has brought into focus a particular aspect of human factors - physical and mental health and wellness, its impact on the performance of aviation personnel and safety, and the criticality to detect and address any issues early. How can organizations better manage human factors to minimize safety risks attributable to the human element, while building a positive safety culture where health and wellness issues are discussed and addressed? In this session, speakers will discuss the challenges faced when dealing with human factors in aviation, opportunities for mitigation, and good practices to upkeep the health and wellness of aviation personnel.
