- A 1-2 page autobiographical summary of your history, what drew you to a career in aviation, and what your future career goals are.
- Two letters of reference from a faculty member, advisor, or training staff at your current academic institution.
- A copy of your academic transcript signed by your registrar showing your aviation curriculum.
- Submit a 30 second video on how you plan to use the scholarship, which the Foundation will use in future promotions regarding the Gloria Heath Scholarship program.
